GUEST EXPERIENCE

GREETER

Greeters help create a welcoming first step for everyone who arrives at CCC. You offer a friendly hello, provide simple direction when needed, and help people feel comfortable as soon as they walk in. If you enjoy meeting new people and appreciate the chance to brighten someone's visit, greeting could be a great place for you to help people feel at home from the moment they arrive.

This role serves on: Thursdays and Sundays

Time commitment: 1–2 times per month

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided

USHER

Ushers help services run smoothly by greeting guests as they enter the venue, assisting with seating, and supporting communion. If you enjoy being a steady and friendly presence, serving as an usher could be a great place for you to help people engage fully in worship.

This role serves on: Thursdays and Sundays

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided

PARKING TEAM

Parking Team volunteers create a warm first impression by directing cars, greeting guests with energy, and helping people feel comfortable before they even step inside. If you enjoy being active and bringing enthusiasm to your service, the parking team could be a great place for you to help guests feel welcomed from the moment they arrive.

This role serves on: Sundays

Time commitment: 1-2 times per month

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided



CAFÉ – COFFEE BREWING & REFILL

Café volunteers keep hospitality flowing by brewing coffee, refreshing supplies, and maintaining clean and inviting beverage stations. If you enjoy simple hands-on tasks that support others in meaningful ways, serving with the café team could be a great place for you to help people feel cared for throughout their visit.

This role serves on: Thursdays and Sundays

Time commitment: 1-2 times per month

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided




RECEPTION FILL-IN

Reception volunteers help the church run smoothly during the week by greeting guests, answering phones, and offering helpful direction. If you enjoy welcoming people and keeping things organized, the reception role could be a great place for you to make visitors feel supported throughout the week.

This role serves on: Flexible weekdays as needed

Time commitment: As needed or 1-2 times per month

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided



LAUNDRY & KITCHEN VOLUNTEERS

Laundry & Kitchen volunteers help keep our shared spaces clean, fresh, and ready for ministry. You support staff and volunteers by preparing areas where people gather and serve. If you enjoy behind-the-scenes work that makes a big difference, this role could be a great place for you to help create environments where ministry can thrive.

This role serves on: Mondays and Fridays

Time commitment: Flexible

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided

ABILITY INCLUSION

BUDDY (KIDS)

Buddies support kids with disabilities by staying with them during class, helping them stay focused, taking breaks with them when needed, and participating in activities alongside them. If you have patience, compassion, and a desire to help every child feel included, serving as a buddy could be a great place for you to help kids experience Jesus in a way that fits their unique needs.

This role serves on: Thursdays and Sundays

Time commitment: 1-2 times per month

Training required: Background check; no prior experience required



ADULT CLASS ASSISTANT

Adult Ability Class Assistants help adults with disabilities participate fully in their class environment. You might take attendance, assist with mobility needs such as pushing wheelchairs, or support participants during activities. If you enjoy encouraging adults of all abilities and helping them engage with community, this role could be a great place for you to provide meaningful support.

This role serves on: Thursdays and Sundays

Time commitment: 1-2 times per month

Training required: Background check; no prior experience required



KIDS ABILITY CLASS VOLUNTEERS

Kids Ability Class volunteers help kids with disabilities engage in a safe and supportive environment. You might play games, help with activities, or read simple stories about Jesus. If you enjoy connecting with kids and want to help create a positive and accessible classroom experience, this role could be a great place for you to help every child feel included.

This role serves on: Thursdays and Sundays

Time commitment: 1–2 times per month

You build relationships over time and help students think about life and faith in ways that matter. Time commitment: Weekly

Training required: Background check; a short leader orientation is provided

Time commitment: 1–2 times per month

Family Food Team volunteers prepare snacks or simple meals for leaders, volunteers, or students during Student Ministry nights. This is a warm and practical way to support those who serve regularly. Time commitment: Once per month

Training required: Background check; a short training session is provided

WOMEN'S MINISTRY

EVENT SET-UP & SUPPORT

Event Set-Up & Support volunteers help in various ways to prepare, facilitate, and host Women's Ministry events throughout the year. You might set up supplies, assist in the kitchen, support hospitality needs, or help with cleanup after the event. If you enjoy creating warm, welcoming environments and serving on a flexible schedule, this role could be a great place for you to support meaningful moments for women in our church.

This role serves on: As scheduled for events

Time commitment: Flexible, based on event schedule

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided



WOMEN AT THE READY

Women at the Ready respond to practical needs within our church family, such as childcare, providing transportation, or other simple acts of care. You'll receive an email whenever a need arises and can choose to respond based on your availability and gifting. If you enjoy caring for others in meaningful, everyday ways, this role could be a great place for you to help support our church body with flexibility and compassion.

This role serves on: As scheduled for needs

Time commitment: Flexible

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided

If you enjoy investing in other men and want to help create experiences that make a lasting difference, serving with Men's Ministry could be a great place for you to support the spiritual growth of the men in our church.

This role serves on: As scheduled for events

Time commitment: Flexible

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided





FACILITIES

FACILITY VOLUNTEERS

Facilities volunteers help keep CCC welcoming, clean, and ready for ministry by supporting a wide range of practical tasks. You might assist with routine cleaning, setting up rooms for events, maintaining outdoor spaces, or helping with seasonal needs like snow removal. There are also opportunities for project-based tasks such as painting, assembling furniture, or assisting with repairs. If you enjoy hands-on work and like seeing the immediate impact of your efforts, this role could be a great place for you to help create environments where ministry can flourish.

This role serves on: Flexible weekday and event-based times

Time commitment: Flexible, based on needs and availability

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided (certain projects may require additional instruction)

BIRTH-TODDLER VOLUNTEERS

Birth-Toddler volunteers help create a warm, safe, and loving environment for our very youngest kids. You may play with little ones, provide snacks or water, assist with diaper changes, or help toddlers engage during a simple lesson. If you enjoy caring for babies and toddlers and want to help make church a peaceful place for families, this role could be a great place for you to support our littlest attenders with gentleness and joy.

This role serves on: Thursdays and Sundays

Time commitment: 1-2 times per month

Training required: Background check; no prior experience required (must be 16 or older to serve in Nursery)

PreK- Kindergarten volunteers help kids learn about Jesus through simple lessons, hands-on activities, and fun classroom routines. You might assist during large group teaching or help reinforce the lesson in a smaller group setting. If you enjoy helping young kids feel known, loved, and ready to learn, this role could be a great place for you to help spark early faith moments.

This role serves on: Thursdays and Sundays

Time commitment: 1-2 times per month

Training required: Background check; no prior experience required

1st-4th Grade volunteers help kids experience Jesus through an energetic mix of play, teaching, and small group discussion. You'll help guide conversations, support teaching moments, and encourage kids as they grow in understanding. If you enjoy helping kids learn in a fun and active environment, this role could be a great place for you to help them build meaningful foundations of faith.

This role serves on: Thursdays and Sundays

Time commitment: 1-2 times per month

Training required: Background check; no prior experience required

RESOURCE PREP VOLUNTEERS

Resource Prep volunteers support Kids Ministry during the week by restocking supplies, preparing crafts, organizing rooms, disinfecting baby toys, doing laundry, and helping classrooms stay ready for weekend services. If you enjoy behind-the-scenes tasks that make ministry smooth and welcoming, this role could be a great place for you to help set kids up for a great experience.

This role serves on: Flexible weekdays (Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday)

Time commitment: Weekly, 1 hour

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided

CHOIR MEMBER

Choir Members help lead our congregation in worship by adding richness and depth to each service. You'll rehearse and learn music together, and join the West service one weekend each month from August to May. If you enjoy singing with others and want to contribute to worship in a meaningful way, serving in the choir could be a great place for you to help shape moments that draw people closer to Jesus.

This role serves on: Thursdays and Sundays

Time commitment: Once per month, plus a weekly rehearsal

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided

Worship Band Members help lead musical worship by serving as vocalists or instrumentalists with a high level of musical skill. After auditioning, you'll rehearse during Thursday soundcheck and serve at all service times for the weekends you're scheduled. If you love using your musical gifts to help people connect with God, serving on the worship band could be a great place for you to support worship in a powerful way.

This role serves on: Thursdays and Sundays

Time commitment: As scheduled, typically once per month

Training required: Audition required; orientation provided after acceptance

PRODUCTION

CAMERA OPERATOR

Camera Operators help capture clear and engaging video for both in-room and online worship. You'll follow direction from the Video Director, frame important moments, and support a distraction-free worship experience. If you enjoy technology and working on a supportive team behind-the-scenes, operating a camera could be a great place for you to help people stay connected to what matters most in every service.

This role serves on: Thursdays and/or Sundays

Time commitment: Typically once per month

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided



CG OPERATOR (COMPUTER GRAPHICS)

CG Operators control the lyrics and slide content that appear on screens during worship services. You'll ensure cues are accurate and on-time for both the room and livestream. If you enjoy detail-oriented tasks and supporting worship from behind-the-scenes, serving as a CG Operator could be a great place for you to help people engage without distraction.

This role serves on: Thursdays and/or Sundays

Time commitment: Typically once per month

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided





COMMUNICATIONS

PHOTOGRAPHER

Photographers help capture meaningful moments from services, ministries, and events so our church family can see and celebrate what God is doing. You'll take photos that help tell the story of CCC and support communication across digital and print platforms. If you have a creative eye and enjoy documenting real moments, and a willingness and aptitude to learn technical skills (equipment), serving as a photographer could be a great fit for you! (Equipment will be provided as needed.)

This role serves on: Thursdays and Sundays, plus special events as scheduled

Time commitment: Typically, once per month or as needed for events (usually 1-2 hours at a time)

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided with follow-up as needed.



SOCIAL MEDIA CAPTURE

Social Media Capture volunteers gather real-time content—photos, short videos, and stories—that help to share how God is working through CCC. You'll capture authentic moments during services or events and contribute to online engagement throughout the week. If you are observant, have an eye for capturing special moments, and enjoy storytelling, this role could be a great place for you to help share what's happening in the life of our church.

Equipment will be provided (Social Media Phone) or, if you have an iPhone 13 or newer, you can use your own phone.

This role serves on: Thursdays and Sundays, plus events as scheduled

Time commitment: Typically once per month (1-2 hours at a time).

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided





SPORTS

GUEST WELCOME & CHECK-IN (CONNECTORS)

Connectors create a warm first impression for families and participants at sports programs. You'll greet players with friendliness, guide new guests through the simple check-in process, and share basic information about upcoming connect opportunities. If you enjoy welcoming people and helping them feel comfortable right away, this role could be a great place for you to help families feel at home from the moment they arrive. Connectors also share what else is happening at CCC so participants can take meaningful next steps.

This role serves on: As scheduled for sports seasons and events

Time commitment: Flexible, based on program schedule

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided

KIDS SPORTS PROGRAMS — COACH OR REFEREE

Coaches and Referees support kids by creating a fun, structured environment that encourages confidence, teamwork, and sportsmanship. All planning and curriculum are provided, so you can focus on building relationships and helping kids grow. If you enjoy sports and mentoring children in simple, meaningful ways, this role could be a great place for you to make a positive impact throughout a sports season.

This role serves on: As scheduled for sports seasons and events

Time commitment: Seasonal (6-8 week commitment depending on sport)

Training required: Background check; no experience required, a short training session is provided

SPORTS PROGRAM LEADER

Each of our sports programs are supported by leaders who are passionate about the sport they serve in. Sports Program Leaders may lead fitness classes and organize basketball, volleyball, pickleball, soccer, flag football, and other sports throughout the year. They help ensure every session runs smoothly, safely, and with excellence. Leaders set the tone by creating a fun and welcoming environment. They are intentional about noticing and connecting with first-timers and helping them feel comfortable. Program Leaders also share what else is happening at CCC so participants can take meaningful next steps.

This role serves on: As scheduled for sports seasons and events

Time commitment: Seasonal (6-8 week commitment depending on sport)

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided

EVENT SET-UP & SUPPORT

Event Set-Up & Support volunteers help prepare, host, and reset Sports Ministry events throughout the year, everything from gym tournaments and field events to 5Ks and other athletic gatherings. You might set up equipment, prepare supplies, assist with registration, support hospitality needs, manage water or aid stations, or help with cleanup and teardown after the event.

This role serves on: As scheduled for events

Time commitment: Flexible, based on event schedule

Training required: Background check for kids events; no experience required, a short training session is provided

DOOR 2 LOGISTICS VOLUNTEERS

Door 2 Logistics volunteers support the ministry by helping prepare, organize, and maintain the art studio and event environments. You might refresh supplies, reset the studio for upcoming classes, prepare materials for creative projects, or help with setup and tear-down for community events. If you enjoy hands-on tasks that keep things running smoothly, serving with the Door 2 Logistics Team could be a great place for you to help create spaces where creativity and connection can thrive.

This role serves on: Tuesdays or Thursdays during the day or Wednesday evenings.

Time commitment: 1-4 hours once or twice a month

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided





MEMBER CARE

PRAYER TEAM — BEFORE WEEKEND SERVICES

Prayer Team volunteers gather before services to pray over the people, ministries, and moments that will take place throughout the weekend. You'll join a small group in lifting up the church, asking God to work through every part of the service. If you enjoy praying for others and want to support the church in a powerful, behind-the-scenes way, this role could be a great place for you to help prepare hearts through prayer.

This role serves on Sundays from 10:15-10:30am in Room 17

Time commitment: Twice per month

Training required: No prior experience; you are welcome to show up!

PRAYER TEAM — AFTER WEEKEND SERVICES

After each service, Prayer Team volunteers are available at the front of the room to pray with individuals who come forward with needs or requests. If you love Jesus, care deeply for others, and enjoy praying with people, this role could be a great place for you to help others encounter God in just a few minutes of meaningful connection.

YOUNG ADULTS

WELCOME TEAM

Welcome Team volunteers help set the tone for Thursday nights by greeting young adults warmly, helping them check in, and making the environment feel inviting. You'll connect with people as they enter East Hall and help create a friendly space where new and returning attendees feel at home. If you enjoy meeting people and offering simple hospitality, this role could be a great place for you to help shape someone's first experience in Young Adults.

This role serves on: Thursdays

Time commitment: Twice per month

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided



CONNECT TEAM

Connect Team volunteers help new attendees feel welcomed, informed, and connected during their first visit. You'll engage with newcomers, walk them through the "New Here" process, introduce them to others, and follow up when appropriate. If you enjoy relational conversations and helping people find belonging quickly, this role could be a great place for you to help new young adults feel at home right away.

This role serves on: Thursdays

Time commitment: Twice per month

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided



ROOM RESET TEAM

Room Reset Team volunteers help return East Hall to its weekday layout after Young Adults gathers. You'll put away chairs, tidy the room, and reset equipment so the space is ready for the next day. If you enjoy behind-the-scenes serving and like helping leaders stay free to connect with young adults after the night ends, this role could be a great place for you to support the ministry in a simple, meaningful way.

This role serves on: Thursdays

Time commitment: Twice per month

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided

Young Adult Mentors support and encourage young adults as they navigate significant life seasons. You'll meet in person monthly, check in weekly by text or call, and pray regularly for the person you're paired with. Time commitment: Monthly in-person meeting + weekly check-ins

Training required: No prior experience; a short training session is provided
